- **SUBJECT:** New Training Session Dates

You have been asked to be notified of upcoming training dates for teh Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Program. Successful completion of this training is required by Alberta Municipal Affairs for those people wishing to obtain a Certificate of Competency (formerly a PSDS ticket) to work in the onsite wastewater industry. This program is also reconginzed in British Columbia under the Trade, investment and Labour Mobility Agreement (TILMA) and the New West Partnership, in Saskatchewan under the New West Partnership and in Manitoba under the agreement on Internal Trade.

The Onsite Wastewater Practitioner Training Program is currently an eight day in-class course and a one-day field training class.

- You must complete all prerequsite training and eight days of classroom training with a passing grade of 75% in order to receive certification.
- You must also complete a mandatory Site and Soil Evaluation Field Training Day. This is the ninth day of training and will be scheduled throughout the installation season. Fees for the Site and Soil Evaluation Field Training Day are included in the tuition fees

The next available training session is a hybrid class and students may attend in-person in Calgary, AB <u>OR</u> virtually on the Zoom platform. The next dates are:

Days 1-4: September 12, 13, 14 and 15, 2023 Days 5-8: September 26, 27, 28 and 29, 2023

If you are interested in participating in a training session listed, please complete the registration form which follows and email or fax it back. Space in the training sessions is limited and is allotted on a first come, first served basis. Upon receipt of the completed form and payment for training, your course supplies will be sent to you for review prior to training. <u>A minimum class of fifteen</u> paid participants is required in order for the class to take place.
